



Annual Report 2022

Dear members, supporters and friends,

As we have done regularly in the past, we would like to inform you about our activities of the past year. As our work in the association is done on a voluntary basis, it can happen that some of our tasks, which are not directly related to the support of the students in Bangladesh, are completed with delay if important family or professional commitments interfere. We are therefore all the more grateful for your loyalty to the association and your membership fees and donations.

Enclosed you will find the most important facts and figures about our commitment in 2022.

Supported Students

A total of 382 students (including 236 girls and 146 boys) from 24 areas in Bangladesh received our sponsorship in 2022. Of these, 31 youths received their SSC (Secondary School Certificate) after class 10 and 25 scholars received their HSC (Higher Secondary School Certificate) after class 12. We warmly congratulate them on their outstanding achievements.

Thanks to your financial support, we were able to increase the number of sponsored students by 24 compared to 2021.

Distribution of Scholarship Funds

In 2022, a total of € 26,476 in regular support was sent to Bangladesh at four-monthly intervals. We would like to take this opportunity to thank the coordinators in Germany and Bangladesh who ensure that the funds reach the students we support regularly and on time.

Financial Situation of the Association

As of 31.12.2022, we had 172 members. The total membership fees in 2022 amounted to € 21,904. This represents a minimal increase compared to € 21,829 in 2021. We were fortunate to receive donations of € 6,543.

In March 2023, the donation receipts for the year 2022 were sent to all members.

As we work consistently on a voluntary basis, our administrative costs are very low. In 2022, they amounted to only 1.48% of income at € 385.

In the last year, two board meetings took place, which mainly dealt with organisational issues, such as money transfer to Bangladesh, distribution of pending work, optimisation of various work processes, improvement of public relations.

The general meeting took place on 23.10.2022. The planned elections of the organs of the association could also be held here. As our previous chairperson Ansiul Haque did not run again for reasons of age, Tariqz Zaman was unanimously elected as the new chairperson of the association. We would like to take this opportunity to thank Mr. Haque for his constructive ideas and his many years of successful commitment for the benefit of the association and the students it supports. We wish Mr Zaman every success in his new challenging position.

The Working Committee has continuously exchanged ideas in online meetings and via email and has contributed significantly to the success of our association with its tireless efforts. For this, a heartfelt thank you from the Association Board and Advisory Board to the members of the Working Committee.

Due to the 2022 Corona restrictions, we were unfortunately unable to hold any cultural events. Also other activities that could make our association and its goals known to the public could not be realised. We hope that we will be able to do so in the near future.
